As of Monday 19<sup>th</sup> March, Plymouth City Council have teamed up with Kingdom Services Group to employ a number of Environmental Enforcement Officers to patrol the streets outside Plymouth's schools to help crackdown on things like dog fouling, littering, fly-posting and fly-tipping. The officers will be able to issue fixed penalty notices to offenders. Littering and fly-posting both carry an £80 penalty while dog fouling costs offenders £100. Fly-tipping is punishable by a £400 fine.
