Dear Parent / Carer,

Re: Sixth Form Consultation – Suspension

The South West Regional Schools Commissioner's (RSC) office have informed us that the application to suspend the sixth form for one year at All Saints Church of England Academy has been declined.

The Head Teachers' Board who met to discuss our case, took the view that a one year suspension would be impractical and suggested we would be better placed to consult on full closure. The Governing Body, in consultation with the Diocese of Exeter and the Ted Wragg Multi Academy Trust have therefore decided to consult on a proposal for the full closure of our Sixth Form provision.

We appreciate that the timing of this consultation is less than ideal, particularly for our current Year 11 students and I would like to reassure you that we will support all of our students to make informed decisions about the next steps of their education throughout this period. With this in mind we will be hosting a "Futures Evening" for students and their families on Monday the 14th May from 4.30pm-7.00pm. This event will provide students and their families with an opportunity to meet with a range of Post 16 providers as well as staff from the Academy in order to openly discuss the options available to them and to address any concerns that they may have.

The six-week consultation period will run from Monday the 7th May to Friday the 15th June to provide all those potentially affected by the proposals, the opportunity to respond. Your feedback is important, and I would encourage you to officially record any views you may have in writing, even if you engaged in the initial consultation.
