All Saints Church of England Academy, Plymouth aims to be an inspirational community of learning, which will transform the life chances of the students and make a positive contribution to the well-being of the local community and the wider world. The Academy is rooted in Christian values including truth, justice, forgiveness, generosity and respect. ## Introduction

The uniform will protect students from social pressures to dress in a particular way and nurture cohesion to promote good relationships between different groups of students.

## Purpose

Blazer Black with Academy badge and purple lining	✓	✓
Sleeveless Academy jumper Black with purple stripe in the neck; only Academy jumper may be worn	✓	✓

Trousers Black, formal style [no denim, cord, jeans, leggings or skinny trousers], a plain black belt may be worn with trousers if it fits through belt loops	✓	✓
Skirt Black, plain or pleated, formal style [no denim, cord, or stretch material] minimum length just above the knee [no frills, no additional detailing, no logos, no leggings]	x	✓
Shoes Plain, black, flat shoes [with no logos or markings]. Please note trainers, boots, suede or canvas shoes are not allowed	✓	✓
Outdoor Coat Students need an outdoor coat, black or dark colour which must be removed in lessons. "Hoodies" are not allowed. An Academy coat with logo can be purchased approx. £14 - £21.50	optional	optional
Bag All students must carry a school bag for books and equipment [Academy bag with logo can be purchased £13]	✓	✓

Girls' tights Should be plain black or neutral	x	✓
