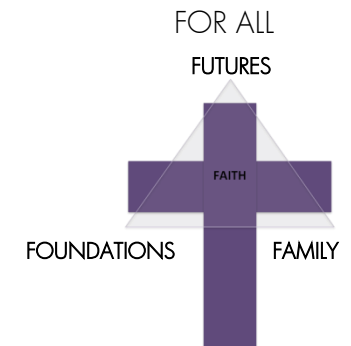

READY TO LEARN

Ready to Learn (RTL) is a whole school behaviour and learning policy which covers all aspects of school life. Its aims are to eliminate disruptive behaviour; provide clarity to staff and students about acceptable behaviour; encourage students to take responsibility for their actions and enable staff to deliver engaging, creative and experimental lessons.

RULES DURING LESSONS

All students at ALL Saints Academy have the right to learn without disruption. We expect students to follow these rules:

- Arrive on time, usually within 3 minutes and by the second bell at the start of the day, after break and after lunch (a 5 minute movement bell will sound for these times).
- Sit where you are told.
- Show you are ready to learn.
- Listen respectfully when others are talking.
- Keep off-task conversations for social times.
- Work in silence when an adult asks you to.
- Allow others to learn.
- Stay in your seat.
- Don't eat or drink (only water is allowed).
- Speak to others with respect.
- Bring your PE kit to PE lessons.

RULES AROUND SCHOOL

At All Saints Academy, we expect everyone to behave with respect at all times. That means walking around the school calmly and quietly, respecting each other's space and looking out for each other.

STUDENTS WHO BREAK THE RULES

If students break a learning rule, they will be given a clear warning by a member of staff and their names will be written on the board. If any further rule is broken, students will be asked to make their way to the Isolation Room. Students will stay in isolation for 5 lessons, including an hour after school; they will be expected to work during their time in isolation. Parents and carers will be contacted by the Behaviour Management Team to confirm that the student will be required to stay for an after-school detention for 1 hour.

Students who refuse to go to the Isolation Room or who continue to cause disruption in isolation, will be excluded from school. Parents and carers will be required to attend a post-exclusion meeting at 8.30am, by arrangement with the Behaviour Management Team.

Students who fail to behave in a sociable and respectful manner around the school and during social times, will be referred for a 20 minute lunchtime detention. Any student failing to attend this detention, will be sent to the Isolation Room.

STUDENTS WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OR DISABILITIES

All students at All Saints Academy are expected to follow school rules so that all can achieve success and be happy at school. The RTL system applies to all students in the school.

The Special Needs Co-ordinator or the Senior Leadership Team will take into account a student's identified special needs or disability when deciding how long a student should spend in their appropriate support areas.
