Summer Project: STILL LIFE

Over the summer holidays you will need to work and respond to the theme 'Still Life'

I will expect to see a short project that shows how your work and ideas have developed over time.

You will need to do the following work;

- **FIRST HAND RECORDINGS** – take photos and draw from real life objects that connect to the project theme. Show as much realism as you can in your work.
- **RESEARCH** – find an artist who is well known for their work with Still Life. Collect images of their work. Create artwork in the style of the artist's work. Write down relevant information about the artist and their work (in your own words). Write down your opinion about the work.
- **DEVELOPMENT OF IDEAS** – using your first hand recordings and the artist work as inspiration, create your own art-work. If you have a range of art equipment, show how you have experimented with different media and materials.
- **FINAL OUTCOME** – create a final outcome showing your own artwork that has clear links to the rest of the work you have done in this mini- project

ART EQUIPMENT

In September you will be expected to have a basic collection of art resources;

- Sketch pencils
- Rubbers
- Sharpeners
- Ruler
- Fine-liners
- Glue sticks

You will be working in A3 sketch books. We can provide you with a basic sketch book but these will not be ordered until we come back in September. Therefore, you may wish to purchase your own sketch book. Please make sure the paper feels thick and of a good quality.
